QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

- As you have grown in your Christian faith, have you adopted new and different names of Jesus than the one you used to call him? What are they?
- Describe the images you think of in the Key Verse, Philippians 2:10.
- Kenosis, the theological term for Jesus' self-emptying of his divine nature, allows Jesus to connect to humanity in an inexplicable way. What does the humanity of Christ mean to you?
- What are the ways in which Paul tells us to be? These model for us the very essence of Christlikeness we strive for. To what ways is Jesus calling you to act during this season of Lent?
