QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

- 1. Tom uses John 20:1-18 in his sermon. What correlation do you see between the scripture in our journals, Luke 6:46-47, and what Tom preached on?
- 2. We don't often consider the women in Jesus' circle as disciples. Why is that? How do you relate to or understand Mary Magdalene as a disciple?
- 3. What is disappointing you in the present? What control do you have over it? How can relinquishing control to God help?
- 4. What does the resurrection mean to you? How does it change the way you view death?
- 5. Mary exclaims that she has seen the Lord! How is Jesus Lord to you?
- 6. Hope and trust can help us create a "new reality." There is a choice to be part of the resurrection and Easter. How are you choosing Easter in the present?
- 7. Easter gives us the promise of new beginnings right now. What new beginnings can you invite into your journey with Christ?
